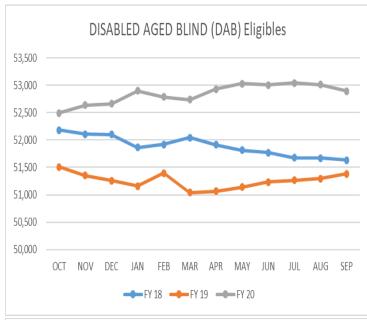


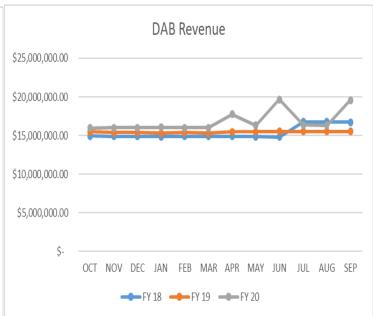
Lakeshore Regional Entity Board Financial Officer Report for November 2020

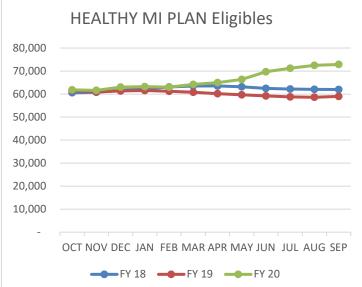
- ♣ A motion is requested to approve the October 2020 disbursements. A summary of those disbursements is included as an attachment.
- ♣ A preliminary Statement of Activities report through September 2020 is also included as an attachment.
- A Bucket Report for September 2020 is included as an attachment for today's meeting. Expense projections, as reported by each CMHSPs, along with notable variances are also included. This month we have incorporated projected direct care wage funding lapses and updates to the performance bonus and ISF amounts for FY20. CMHSP expense projections will likely continue to change for a couple of months while final provider billings are received and processed.
- Revenue projections continue to be updated monthly as payment and membership data is received. Our first payment for FY21 was received last month. Updated **revenue and membership projections by program and CMHSP were created.** A summary of our analysis is attached to this report for your review. Revenue projections reflect an increase of \$2,725,524 mainly for increases in membership that were in our first payment along with a few adjustments to our FY21 rate cells.
- → Direct Care Worker Increase Extension As reported last month, legislation was passed to add \$150 million to the state budget for a temporary \$2.00 per hour wage increase for the first quarter in FY21 (October-December 2020). CMHSPs continued to maintain wage increases for October and will continue to do so through December. PIHPs have been informed that DCW payments will be included in their capitation payments for November.
- ♣ SUD Block Grant Budget Cuts Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) and the Office of Recovery Oriented Systems of Care (OROSC) have alerted all PIHP's that there are budget cuts to FY21 SUD Block Grant (BG) of approximately \$20 million due to multiple years of over-allocating its block grant dollars. Our region has been cut approximately \$2.3 million in the SUD BG for Treatment. LRE will work with the State, providers, and CMHSPs to identify funding streams that can be used to help offset the drastic reduction in the BG allocation for this year. Budget amendments will be proposed and presented during upcoming meetings with the LRE Board and Oversight Policy Board for approval.
- ♣ Financial Data/Charts The following page contains an annual and monthly comparison of the number of individuals in our region who are eligible for each program. The number of eligible individuals in our region determines the amount of revenue the LRE receives each month. Fiscal years 18 and 19 are used for this illustration. The LRE also receives payments for other individuals who are not listed on these charts but are eligible for behavioral health services (i.e. individuals enrolled and eligible for the Habilitation Supports Waiver (HSW) program). The charts below also show the revenue comparisons by month and year. Overall, you will notice the number of eligibles in the region is consistently higher for all populations which is significantly different than the drops experienced in FY19. This has a direct impact on the amount of revenue the LRE receives.

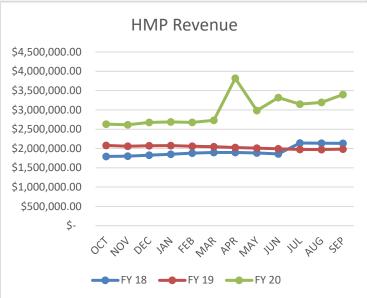

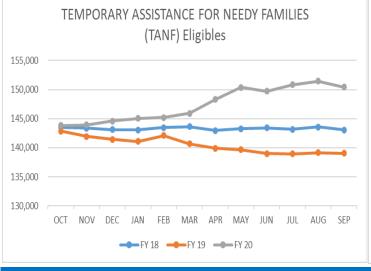


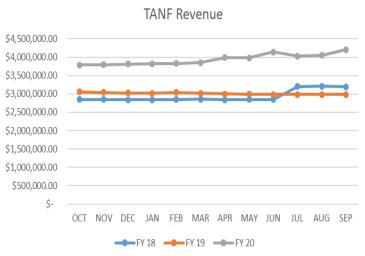
