

Provider Quality Review Tool Contents of Spill Kit and Emergency Bag

Spill Kit (should be complete and readily accessible)

- 1. Absorbent Material
- 2. Antiseptic Cleansing Wipes
- 3. Biohazard Bags
- 4. Bodily Fluid Pick-up Guide
- 5. Disposable Gloves
- 6. Disposable Clean-up Towels
- 7. Disposable Gown
- 8. Disposable Shoe Covers
- 9. Eye Shields
- 10. Germicidal Wipes
- 11. Scooper

Emergency Bag (best practice: wheeled)

- 1. Blankets & Raincoats (enough for each resident)
- 2. Battery-operated radio
- 3. Appropriate batteries (best practice: packaged)
- 4. Flashlight
- 5. Resident Profiles (meds, physician/allergies, guardian, etc.)
- 6. First Aid Kit Disposable Briefs (if appropriate)
- 7. Wet wipes/Hand Sanitizer
- 8. Disposable Gloves
- 9. Keys to van & house
- 10. Other: cell phone, flares, reflectors for van, etc.
- 11. Food Items (best practice: expiration date labeled)
- 12. Bottled Water
- 13. Sugar-free and other special foods if necessary
- 14. Staff telephone numbers
- 15. Process to contact others (management, staff)
- 16. Weather or battery-operated radio is accessible and in working order
- 17. Checklist to monitor the emergency bag contents. The list should include:
 - Who completed the list
 - Completeness of the bag(s)
 - Frequency of monitoring
 - Needs identified/implemented (if home with more than 1 additional staff person)
