

BIOTERRORISM PLAN

Reporting Requirements and Contact Information

Healthcare facilities may be the initial site of recognition and response to bioterrorism events. If a bioterrorism event is suspected:

- Clients and staff should be evacuated
- Local emergency response systems should be activated.
- Notification should immediately include the senior administration, and prompt communication with the local and state health departments, FBI field office, local police, CDC, and medical emergency services.
